WOF YEAR END

The Board of Directors of the Widows and Orphans Fund held the Annual General Meeting on April 7. At that meeting the Directors reviewed the Annual report of the Fund. The following are some of the highlights of the report. Total revenues for year ended December 31, 2009 were \$4,600,440 versus \$2,240,105 for the year prior. Total death and retirement benefits paid were \$2,296,794 compared to \$2,713,058 a year earlier. The Fund increased the death benefit in 2010 resulting in additional actuarial reserves of \$2,496,320. The assets of the Fund as of December 31 were \$71,776,292 with liabilities of \$63,617,085 and a surplus of \$8,159,207. The total value of our in force insurance package is \$407,201,000. The auditor provided a clean opinion.

In addition to the audit at year end, the Fund also undergoes an actuarial review. Our Actuarial Consultants, Eckler Partners, confirms the favourable position of the Fund. Reports of each of the committees are available by calling the office at 416-502-8711.

The Board would like to acknowledge the work and commitment of Investment Committee Chair, Larry Molyneux. Larry will remain on the committee but is stepping down as Chair. Bob Spafford, representing the Credit Union on the Board, will take over as Chair.
